### Preface

This edition of Facts and Figures on Education updates information on development cooperation in the education sector. The information provided is based on disbursements made by Sida (i.e. not plans or budgets).

Sida's Education Sector Cooperation has increased its share of Sida's total Development Cooperation from six per cent in 2001 to eight per cent in 2002, mainly due to a substantial increase in the support to Primary Education.

Education Division in the Department for Democracy and Social Development (DESO) and the Swedish Embassies administered most (54%) of Sida's education cooperation in 2002. However, many departments at Sida are engaged in supporting education, in particular the Department for Cooperation with NGOs and Humanitarian Assistance (SEKA) and the Department for Research Cooperation (SAREC).

SAREC's support to Higher Education is included in this report. However, SAREC's support classified as support to Higher Education represents only a fraction of SAREC's total support to Research Development to developing countries.

During 2002, the strategy of Sector Programme Support in the education sector was further implemented. This shift; from support to sub-programmes or basic education projects to sector programme support, has effect on the statistics, especially on sub-sector and activities. As support to sector programmes increases, areas such as Education Material or Adult/Literacy Education may decrease. It is important to note that these areas may still receive indirect support through General Education or Sector Support.

New agreements on programme support in the education sector were signed in respect of Rwanda and Mali in 2002. In the case of Rwanda, Sector Support to primary education increased from 2.6 MSEK in 2001 to 30.1 MSEK in 2002.

Another important development in education cooperation in 2002 can be exemplified by the support to Afghanistan. As the situation in the country has changed, so has the form of support. In 2002 Sida supported UNICEF's Back to School-campaign in Afghanistan, a campaign that resulted in the enrolment of 2.9 million children in one form of education or another. According to UNICEF, the enrolment rate increased by

60 per cent, and the enrolment of girls by 90 per cent. Sida's support consisted of 31 MSEK administered by SEKA, supplemented by an additional 32 MSEK administered by the Education Division and the Regional Secretariat for Asia.

Further information on different kinds of education sector cooperation and on policies, strategies and results is available at the departments concerned at Sida.

I hope that the information presented in this document will be useful for analyses, presentations and strategic planning of future development cooperation.

### 1. Summary

In 2002 Sida disbursed SEK 863 million to programmes classified as education programmes. The year 2002 represents a year of recovery from the decline in education cooperation disbursements in 2001 (688 MSEK).

Approximately 54% of this amount was administered by DESO/ Education Division and the Swedish Embassies in the partner countries. Primary Education received 56 per cent, 481.4 MSEK, of Sida's total Education Cooperation in 2002.

The region in the world that received most education support was Africa, which received 61% of all disbursements to Education.

The ten countries that received the main part of the disbursements were: Tanzania, Mozambique, Afghanistan, Bolivia, Bangladesh, Rwanda, Cambodia, Uganda, South Africa, Namibia and Mali. In the case of Afghanistan the disbursements were made mainly from the Sida Regional Secretariat for Asia and the Department for Co-operation with NGOs and Humanitarian Assistance (SEKA) and, in the case of Uganda mainly from from the Department for Research Cooperation, SAREC.

# 2. Sida Education Cooperation

#### 2.1 An Overview of Swedish education cooperation

The overall policy goal of Sida's co-operation in the education sector is to enhance the right to relevant education for all – an education that empowers the poor and excluded parts of the population to participate as active and informed citizens in all aspects of development.

Since April 2001, Sida has had a new policy for cooperation in the education sector, *Education for all – a human right and basic need.* 

The policy emphasises the goal of Universal Primary Education for All by 2015 as a necessary building block for all Sida's support for capacity development, education, training and research.

The policy is based on internationally agreed concepts and goals declared in Human Rights conventions and declarations.

Sida is strongly committed to the Millenium Development Goal of halving the proportion of people living in extreme poverty by 2015. Two of the targets concern education:

- the achievement of Universal Primary Education by 2015
- the elimination of gender disparity in primary and secondary education by 2005.

Sida is committed to the six goals in "The framework for Action in Education for All" (EFA), adopted in Dakar, in April 2000.

Sida's support to the education sector is always based on partner countries' own education programmes. Basic education and literacy for all, children, youth and adults, has been the priority of Swedish development co-operation since the mid-1970s.

With Sida's new education policy implies a shift from support to basic education projects or sub-programmes to support for the education strategies for partner countries that give priority to basic education for all.

The main partners in the education sector cooperation are ministries of education. Other partners are the UN agencies and national and international (Swedish) non-governmental organisations.


In 2002, Sida disbursed 863 MSEK in the form of education cooperation this represents an increase in disbursements as compared the previous year (688 MSEK in 2001).


Development cooperation in the education sector was disbursed from Sida by the following organisational units:

- Bilateral (Country Programmes) and regional programmes and Development Funds disbursed 465 MSEK a slight increase on 2001 (378 MSEK) and were administred by the Swedish Embassies in the partner countries and Education Division at the Department for Democracy and Social Development, DESO.
- Disbursements to development cooperation in the education sector through Swedish NGOs and Humanitarian Assistance amounted to 235 MSEK an increase on 2001 (214 MSEK in 2001) and was administred by the *Department for Cooperation with NGOs and Humanitarian* Assistance, SEKA.
- Research Cooperation is administred by the Department for Research Cooperation, SAREC. SAREC's total support to Higher Education and Research amounted to 846 MSEK and was distributed for bilateral cooperation and as support to regional and global programmes.
   Bilateral research cooperation is mainly directed towards institutions for Higher Education. In 2002 this support amounted to 235 MSEK. About half of this sum is classified as support to Higher Education (124 MSEK) and accounted for in this report. The other half is shown under other sector headings.
- Education cooperation with Central and Eastern Europe amounted to 7 MSEK, a decrease compared to 2001 (14 MSEK) and was administred by the *Department for Central and Eastern Europe, Sida-EAST*.

#### 2.2 Sida Education Cooperation by Geographical Distribution


In 2002 Sida's education cooperation was disbursed to all continents in the world. Most support was given to the African countries 61% (MSEK 527) of all disbursements in 2002. Support to Asian countries was accounted for 20% (MSEK 173), Latin America by 11% (MSEK 97) and Central and eastern Europe by 2 per cent (MSEK 17) of total disbursements in 2002. Support to international organisations and funds and international working groups accounted for 6 per cent (MSEK 49) of total disbursement in 2002.


